#### 1840 Israel Jenkins House

This Greek Revival home was named "The Elms" for the stately Elm trees that lined the lane-or was it a code name used to identify the site as an Underground Railroad station? Learn of the

unexplained occurrences during the renovation of the Israel Jenkins House in the 1990s that prompted a visit by the Indiana Chapter of Ghost Trackers.
